CAMPING

Non-motorized dispersed camping is permitted throughout the Manzanita Mountains without permit. Camping is prohibited at all designated trailheads which are closed from 10pm - 6am.

Motorized travel is only permitted on designated trails and roads as shown on the district Motor Vehicle Use Map (MVUM) as well as this map. There are six "motorized camping corridors" in the Manzanita Mountains Trail System whereas motorized travel for camping (also known as "car camping") is permitted up to 40' from the centerline of the following:
